Overview
<p>The Co-Governance mechanisms in the deeds of settlement provide for governance of River management and planning based on the principles of partnership and consensus decision-making as a general rule. In particular, it includes the Waikato River Authority that includes 50/50 representation of River Iwi and Crown appointees.</p> <p>The following questions ask for your view on seven high-level questions about the integrity of the deeds of settlement and the intent of the Co-Governance framework.</p> <p>Each question also allows you to provide responses with reference to four themes across the deeds of settlement, being:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Te Mana o Te Awa: consideration and recognition of the status of the Waikato and Waipā Rivers.• Kaitiakitanga: the ability of Iwi and the Crown to protect and care for the Waikato and Waipā Rivers.• Health and Wellbeing: the reciprocal ability of the Rivers to provide for the health and wellbeing of the River Iwi and the wider community, and the River Iwi's ability to provide for the health and wellbeing of the Rivers.• Rangatiratanga and partnership: River Iwi participation in delivery of services for the Rivers and the relationships between the Crown and River Iwi.
