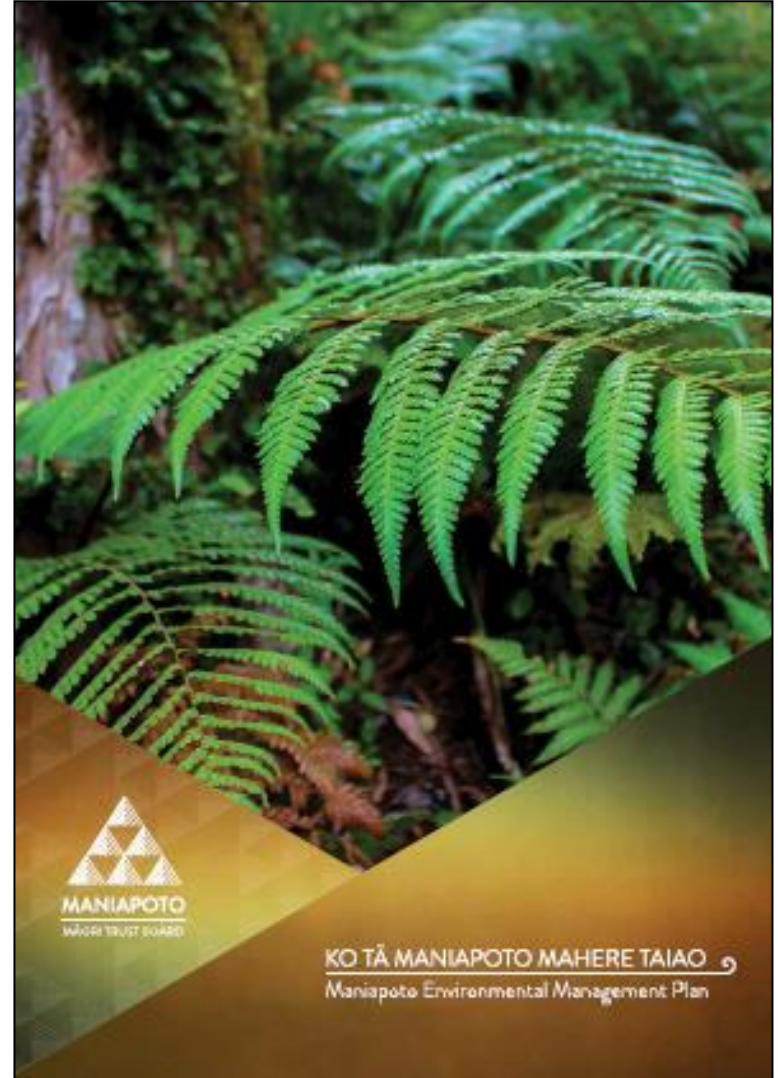

Environmental sustainability

- Maniapoto perspectives on environmental issues and activities that may impact on natural resources and cultural heritage



Who should use the EMP?

- Assist Maniapoto participation and decision making in Resource Management Act (RMA) matters
- guide and assist council officers/decision makers in RMA matters
- Anyone using, intending to use, or affecting natural resources within the Maniapoto rohe



Legislative weighting

- RMA section 35A, MMTB Iwi Authority
- Ngā Wai o Maniapoto Waipā River Act 2012 Part 3 section 15 & 16
- Local Authorities (plans and resource consents)
- Fisheries Act 1996
- Conservation legislation
- Government agencies



Engagement and Consultation

- Must discuss proposals with mana/tāngata whenua.
- MMTB supports
 - the highest target or measure that achieves or exceeds the objectives and policies in the EMP.
 - Other whānau, hapū, marae, Māori land trusts resource management plans

Structure of the EMP

Structure of the Chapters

- **Introduction:** introduces chapter
- **Issues:** Describes issues of concern around the matter being discussed in the chapter.
- **Objectives:** High level goals or direction that address the matters raised in the issues section
- **Policies:** Outline the course of action to achieve the objective
- **Actions:** Outlines methods to promote and support the policies
