



2016 Mandate Proposal

DECLARATION OF RESULT

The final result for the mandate proposal ratification that closed at 5pm on Friday 4 November 2016 is:

Resolution:

That Te Iwi o Maniapoto mandate the Maniapoto Māori Trust Board to enter into negotiations with the Crown to negotiate a comprehensive settlement of all Maniapoto Historical Treaty of Waitangi Claims on behalf of Te Iwi o Maniapoto.

The majority (being 72.01%) of valid votes cast on the resolution AGREED with the proposal.

The voter return was 24.96%, being 2,968 votes received from 11,891 eligible voters, of which 56.10% voted by post or at a hui and 43.90% voted on the internet.
