The Maniapoto Māori Trust Board (MMTB) and Maniapoto Fisheries Trust (MFT) provide funding assistance to those fully registered on the MMTB/MFT Tribal Register and welcome your application for possible financial assistance. The funding is for groups who seek to improve the wellbeing, prosperity, health and cultural competencies for Maniapoto in Maniapoto.

ROOPU CATEGORY	
Cultural and Prosperity (group events)	\$600.00
Health and Wellbeing (group events)	\$500.00

### APPLICATION CRITERIA:

1. Preference will be given **to first-time applicants/groups**
2. Applicants **must** be fully registered on the Maniapoto Tribal Register
3. Completed applications are received six (6) weeks prior to the start of the purpose
4. Funding **may not** be used for Capital purchases, payments for services, wages, clothing or uniforms
5. Funding can be used for venue costs, equipment hireage, catering, stationary or participation fees
6. Funds will be credited to a Group/Marae bank account OR an individual's account **provided** the deposit slip has been signed by Chairperson and/or Kaumatua supporting the application and kaupapa
7. The purpose for which funding is provided must take place within the MMTB/MFT financial year which is 1 October to 30 September

### INITIATIVE EXAMPLES THAT WILL BE CONSIDERED ARE:

- a) Hapū/Marae/Whanau wānanga to increase Te Reo o Maniapoto for paepae (Cultural Competency)
- b) Hapū/Marae/Whanau wānanga to educate Maniapoto tikanga, kawa and hitori, waiata, (Cultural Competency)
- c) Events that promotes Maniapoto health, wellbeing and positive lifestyle changes (Wellbeing)
- d) Training programs that help increase Maniapoto financial literacy, governance training, health and safety training, Taiao training, and capability and capacity building for marae, hapū, and whanau as a pathway out of poverty (Prosperity)
